2.1 Visa

“European Community passport holders do not need a visa to visit Germany. Many other nationals are also exempt for stays of up to 3 months, however, if in doubt we advise you to check before travelling. All visa information for Germany is available on the website of the German Embassy.”

2.2 Identity Card

Before travelling to Germany you need to have a current identity card if you are in the European Community otherwise you need a passport.

2.3 Further entry requirements

Advice for travelling by car:

1. blood alcohol limit while driving a car:
 - a. people under the age of 21 are prohibited to have any blood alcohol limit
 - b. all the other people are *allowed* to have a blood alcohol limit of 0,3 per mill, but you can still get into trouble, please don't drink and drive
2. speed limit:
 - a. city limit 50km/h if not marked otherwise
 - b. country road 100km/h if not marked otherwise
 - c. Autobahn no limit if not marked otherwise
3. it is necessary to be in possession of a valid driver license
 - a. either an international driver license or
 - b. a German driver license

Health:

No vaccinations are required for entry into Germany.

It is recommended to travel with international health insurance.

All riders must wear an approved life vest and a helmet in the course at all times.
All participants ride at their own risk.
No aluminum fins allowed.

6.5 Category Wakeskate

Open Men & Open Ladies: No age restriction

6.6 License / IWWF Membership

All riders should be current member of their respective country's **IWWF affiliated Federation**.
In addition, entrants from EAME should have the EAME International Wakeboard License (National Federations register their riders license online).

6.7 Entry Fee

The entry fee is **60€ per competitor**.
You have to pay the Entry fee and complete all required registration paperwork **no later than Friday August 17th 2012 at 6 pm CET**.

6.8 Onsite registration and paperwork

All riders must register on Friday August 17th from 4-7pm.
Don't forget to bring your passport or ID as well as a copy of your license with you.
The rider's registration will take place at StrandArena.
